The Pastor's Desk:

Eternal Values

As I watched parents, grandparents and students during our awards chapel last week, I was reminded of this passage:

"So whether we are at home or away, we make it our aim to please Him. For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may receive what is due for what he has done in the body, whether good or bad" (2 Corinthians 5: 9-10).

This passage tells us plainly that there is coming a moment in our lives that we will all stand before our Master Conductor, Jesus and "receive what is due" for what we have done in the body, whether good or bad.


