- **Personal Faith:** A profession of faith in Jesus Christ and agreement with the school's statement of faith. Be an active member of a like-minded church.
- **Education:** Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution.
- **Character:** Demonstrates a mature, Christian servant's heart and a passion for teaching middle school students.
